

The Britt City Council met in special session on October 17, 2017 at 6:00p.m. in Council Chambers at City Hall.

Mayor Arndorfer called the meeting to order with Council Persons Ostercamp, Gast, and Verbrugge answering roll. Council person Aitchison and Luecht absent. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor Arndorfer.

DISCUSSION by Council, Mayor, and City Clerk on the benefits of a Capital Project Levy. If approved by vote on November 7, 2017, the City would see an approximate additional \$33,500 in revenue that can be used on fire equipment, police safety equipment, public works safety equipment, city vehicles, infrastructure, and streets. The additional income would allow the city to bond for less on these projects which in turn frees up some of the city's bonding capacity and reduces the amount of interest that is paid to finance projects.
