

## ORDINANCE NO. 505

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY  
BRITT, IOWA, 2020, BY DELETING SECTION 6-5-8 AND SUBSTITUTING A  
NEW SECTION 6-5-8 PERTAINING TO WATER RATES.

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BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Britt, Iowa:

Section 1. Code of Ordinances of the City of Britt, Iowa, is amended by deleting Section 6-5-8 and substituting the following:

### 6-5-8 WATER RATES.

A. Water shall be furnished at the following rates per residential property serviced:

1. Starting February 1, 2021

Service Charge (no water included) at a rate of \$9.00  
Usage Cost per 1,000 gallons at a rate of \$5.00

2. Starting June 1, 2021

Service Charge (no water included) at a rate of \$13.50  
Usage Cost per 1,000 gallons at a rate of \$7.50

3. Starting November 1, 2021

Service Charge (no water included) at a rate of \$20.25  
Usage Cost per 1,000 gallons at a rate of \$11.25

4. Starting July 1, 2022

Service Charge (no water included) at a rate of \$21.26  
Usage Cost per 1,000 gallons at a rate of \$11.81

B. Water shall be furnished at the following rates per commercial/industrial property serviced:

1. Starting February 1, 2021

Service Charge (no water included) at a rate of \$11.00  
Usage Cost per 1,000 gallons at a rate of \$5.50

2. Starting June 1, 2021

Service Charge (no water included) at a rate of \$16.50  
Usage Cost per 1,000 gallons at a rate of \$8.25

3. Starting November 1, 2021

Service Charge (no water included) at a rate of \$24.75  
Usage Cost per 1,000 gallons at a rate of \$12.38

4. Starting July 1, 2022

Service Charge (no water included) at a rate of \$25.25  
Usage Cost per 1,000 gallons at a rate of \$12.62

Section 2. Repealer Clause. Any Ordinance provision, or part thereof, which differs or is inconsistent with this Ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of said difference or inconsistency.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, provision or part of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or any section provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval, posting and publication as required by law.
